How do you consult and inform parents about their child's SEN and involve them and the child in their education?

At St George`s parents and carers are fully involved in the process of working with their children.

The SEND team consists of Mrs Hurst (SENCo) and Mrs Johnson Taylor (Children & Family Support Manager).

- Any child at St George`s who has an additional need is provided with extra support. This is by the class teacher, SENCo and communicated to parents/carers via class teachers during conversations and parent interviews. An Individual Provision Map is sent out twice a year to parents which explains the provision that the child will receive and by whom and when it will be taking place.

Any child with a statement of need or an EHCP is invited to the annual review and can request additional reviews if they feel their child's needs have changed. Children and parents views are also gathered through this process.

- Parents/carers can also request a suitable time to speak with the class teacher or SENCo after school. If parents/carers are unable to bring their children to school, they are encouraged to ring school if information needs to be shared. Please call the following number 01952 387750.
- The SENCo (Mrs Hurst) is in school Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday every week. Mrs Johnson Taylor (Children and Family support Manager) is available every morning until 12.00.
